

Weekend Masses at Sacred Heart

Our facilities suffered extensive water damage this past weekend. The contractor anticipates that the main sanctuary will **not** be usable for the next four to five weekends.

Our current plan is to hold weekend Masses in Founders Hall at 4:30 on Saturday and 8:00AM, 9:30AM and 11:00AM on Sunday. Faith Formation classes will run from 9:15 to 10:45.

Founders Hall will accommodate about 400 people per Mass (per Fire Marshall), significantly less than the main sanctuary. To avoid having standing room only at the 11:00 Sunday Mass, **we need some parishioners who normally attend that Mass to attend the earlier 8:00 or 9:30 Sunday Mass.**

As you can imagine, Mass in the hall will provide some challenges. There are no kneelers and space will be tight, so bowing where we would normally kneel is appropriate. Handicapped access will also be a challenge. We will be temporarily marking spots closest to the hall for handicapped parking, so please respect the new signage. We will learn some lessons this weekend that will make the following weekends better. Please be flexible, put our inconveniences in perspective (we have AC and lights), and focus on the Eucharist which is our highest priority in worship.

Weekday Masses and Adoration Chapel Update

Due to continuing repairs to both the Sanctuary and Chapel, daily Mass will be celebrated in Founders Hall starting Wednesday, October 3rd at 8:00 AM until further notice.

Perpetual Adoration will be suspended beginning Wednesday, October 3rd before daily Mass until further notice. We appreciate your patience as this work is necessary to re-open our Church.
